VICTORIA Melbourne. 60 Stuart Street, Armadale. \$4m

The home of a pair of architects is always going to be something special. This property has been home to Ian and Samantha Perkins, of Perkins Architects, for 25 years. The facade is classic early 1900s, with weatherboard cladding, wraparound veranda and a box bay window. In the rear is a light-filled extension with walls of glass overlooking the garden, heated pool and in-ground trampoline. There is a covered area for entertaining, with fireplace and barbecue. There are four bedrooms, three bathrooms and a self-contained studio in the rear.

QUEENSLAND Townsville. 290 Stanley Street, North Ward. \$1.7m

You can enjoy beautiful sunsets and ocean views from this architect-designed home atop Castle Hill. The property is one of only three on a no-through street, so offers privacy as well as exclusivity. Set across two levels on a 904sq m block, the house has six bedrooms and two bathrooms. Decks extend off the living space on both levels to take in the views and there is a pool.
